1- RACB invitation

2- Entry to the circuit

Access to the circuit is conditioned to the presentation of :

- The result of a **negative PCR or antigen test less than 72 hours old.**
- The "**Racing Safe. Health First**" charter signed by all persons present on the essential persons list

Vaccinated persons are also subject to the presentation of a negative PCR or antigenic test result less than 72 hours old.

Antigenic (salivary) tests can be done on site (for those who do not have a PCR or antigenic test). These tests will take place in the Skyboxes (RallyCross Tribune - Ster entrance).

Results will be available within 15 minutes.

The cost of the tests is €25.

PADDOCK

The access on the paddock Vert can be made on **Thursday, June 17th** from **08:00 am.**

Teams will be able to park in the parking at the Blanchimont entry from **08:00 pm on Wednesday, June 16th.**

The dismantling of the structures will be possible after the race 2 of the Porsche Carrera Cup France.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATION

A supplementary regulation of this meeting will be published soon.

PITLANE

We will use the **F1 pitlane** throughout the weekend.

The speed limit in the pit lane is limited to **60 km/h.**

PASSES

The passes and car parks used for this meeting will be those used during the Paul Ricard meeting.

PRE-SILENCERS

Cars must not be equipped with lateral pre-silencers.

TIRES

Following the introduction of the new rear tyre (N3 R), Michelin will offer each car entered **2 front** and **2 rear tyres** for the first N3R race.

For the Spa-Francorchamps round:

- **Only, the previously marked rear tyres (N3) will be usable during the free practices.**
- **Only, the N3R rear tyres will be registrable.**
