

## REGULATIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS IN SPORTING EVENTS

### Rules of conduct

1. Respect the **prohibition of smoking** in closed establishments and other areas indicated in accordance with current regulations.
2. In the areas that are required, you will dress your **clothes with decorum and respect for others** and for the event.
3. It is forbidden to light **a fire** in any part of the circuit (except gas or electric stoves).
4. It is forbidden to make **noise** after 20:00 hours and until 08:00 hours.
5. The facilities may not be used to carry out **activities** that have **not** previously been declared and expressly **authorized**. (Parties, temporary kitchens, etc.)
6. Keep the proper composure and avoid actions that may create situations of danger or discomfort to the general public, other participants and company personnel or hinder the development of the show or activity.

### About the handling of vehicles

1. Those who circulate with motor vehicles must have the corresponding administrative authorization.
2. You cannot circulate with more people than seats have the vehicle.
3. The maximum speed of circulation by vehicle, off the track, will be 30 km / h.

### About prohibited objects

The requirements or rules of access and admission established in general by the company and made known by means of visible posters placed in the places of access must be met, among which are the prohibition of access of:

1. Any kind of weapons or objects that could produce the same effects, as well as flares, firecrackers, explosives or, in general, flammable, smoking or corrosive products.

2. Containers of beverages or food, which are made of glass, metal, wood, ceramics or similar outside the tents or buildings enabled as restoration.
3. Alcoholic beverages during the opening to the public, toxic drugs, narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances or are under their effects.
4. Animals, except guide dogs as established in RD 3250/1983.

### On the use of accreditations

5. If you have a personal pass, you must always carry it visible and show it every time it is requested by the security or organization personnel.

### About security measures

1. Participants may submit to the relevant checks for the verification of the conditions of access and permanence, and in particular:
  1. Be recorded by closed circuit television in the vicinity of the sports venue, in its accesses and inside them.
  2. Submit to personal records aimed at verifying the obligations contained in the conditions of access.
1. In general, the minimum age to access the pit lane or roads will be 15 years.
